

SNOWDROP PLACE BOTLEY

A HIGH-END 68-BEDROOM CARE HOME PROVIDING RESIDENTIAL AND SPECIALIST DEMENTIA CARE.



Highwood was the principal contractor for a new-build scheme at Pavilion Road on the vast Botleigh Grange site in the Hampshire village of Hedge End. The project to deliver a high-end 68bed care home to provide an array of specialist care for the elderly was designed by WR Dunn architects and developed by Frontier Estates, the leading UK healthcare sector development partner.

Highwood successfully tendered for the project to construct the Snowdrop Place Care Home, which is operated by Barchester Healthcare and registered to offer residential, nursing and dementia care.

The two-storey care home incorporates a brick and timber clad façade with large terraces on the first floor and two accommodation wings either side. The home has been designed to provide accommodation in excess of current Care Quality Commission (CQC) requirements, offering a multitude of residential day spaces that include café,

hairdressers, lounges, dining rooms, private dining and a cinema.

Despite the constraints of operating on site throughout the Covid-19 lockdown and with complex safety measures and working restrictions to navigate, the project remained on course at every stage and welcomed its first residents in 2021.











ROYAL COURT NETLEY

ONE OUR MOST HIGH-PROFILE COMBINED RETIREMENT AND CARE PROJECTS.



Royal Court is a stunning development comprising nine, one and two-bedroom luxury retirement apartments and a 65-bedroom care home.

The land, which incorporated the grounds of a former special needs school, had been the subject of much speculation and a challenging market, but Highwood successfully secured the site and embarked on a complex, but comprehensive planning bid.

We were granted planning consent for our proposals that included a complete refurbishment of the main house and the development of a new care home, which would enhance the existing

building and its delightful coastal environment. The application for the overall scheme was met with approval and support from Eastleigh Borough Council. The authority saw the value in providing much-needed accommodation for residents looking for dedicated, stylish retirement living and high-quality nursing care when required.

IMPECCABLE CARE FACILITIES

Set close to the shores of one of the south coast's premier sailing waters and within the beautiful Netley Abbey Conservation Area, Royal Court was a considered scheme that put luxury, security and impeccable care facilities for its residents first. The nine apartments featured concierge services, luxurious specifications, private landscaped gardens and stunning views across Southampton Water.


Following two grand launches, this exclusive waterside retirement development opened its doors to its first residents and interest in the prestigious new care home was an overwhelming triumph.

HAMILTON COURT & ABERCORN HOUSE, CAMBERLEY

A PRESTIGIOUS CLOSE CARE SCHEME OF 12 ASSISTED LIVING APARTMENTS AND A 90-BED CARE HOME.



Highwood was contracted to build a stunning close-care scheme of apartments and prestigious care home on a site in Camberley in Surrey for Gracewell Healthcare.

Abercorn House, a state-of-the-art 90-bed care home, was traditionally constructed over five floors on a sloping site that incorporated basement construction on the lower ground floor. The design included extensive terraces into the structure, with high specification landscaping works and a highways agreement for the site entrance and road improvement works to the exterior. Abercorn House is a full en-suite accommodation facility with

exemplary communal facilities that include beautiful living rooms and dining rooms and relaxing outside spaces for everyone to enjoy.

A HIGH SPECIFICATION **CARE HOME DELIVERED ON TIME**

Hamilton Court is two-storey apartment building that sits on the existing Hamilton Court site and is now serviced via the new Abercorn House scheme. The build contract was negotiated directly with Hamberley and included the completion of a partially constructed 90-bed care home and 12 assisted living apartments

after the initial contractor had gone out of business. Highwood reappointed the consultant team and some of the original supply chain who had already worked on the scheme to successfully deliver a quality home that met the high standards previously delivered on other Gracewell schemes.

Following a full survey and assessment of the condition of the existing construction, a full scope of remedial works was agreed and construction was completed on time with Gracewell Healthcare taking occupation the following month.


